It's hard to know if Stephen is better known as a clinician or as a competitor. He represented the United States in Olympic competition in Barcelona in 1992. In 1993, he was only the second American in history to win Great Britain's prestigious Burghley CCI\*\*\*\*, following in the footsteps of his mentor, Eventing legend Bruce Davidson. In both 2003 and 2007, Stephen was a member of the gold medal winning US team at the Pan American Championships on Brandenburg's Joshua and From respectively.

Stephen has earned a reputation over the many years for being a classy, quiet, tactful, patient but effective rider. He freely admits that's he's old school, and he teaches much the same as he rides; classy, quiet, tactful, patient but effective. When asked how he stays fresh for teaching, Stephen looks surprised and answers "because I love it!" And you can tell by watching him and listening to him that it's true. He's engaged, he laughs, he listens. Stephen's enthusiasm, talent for communication and ability to inspire confidence in the horse and rider make him a hit with all levels.
